

Teacher's Notes for Numbering Buttons

This work sheet allows pupils to write in missing numbers on circular buttons. It is intended to be a piece of work that helps to fulfil the aims the Year 1 Study requirements that pupils should:

Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number

Objective: Pupils practise the identification of numbers from the ordinal pattern and acquire an understanding of this at their respective level of ability

Methodology: Pupils work through the sheet with the more able pupils going on to numbers greater than 100. Answers are checked and concepts developed via a PowerPoint presentation
